Annotatsiya: Ushbu maqola global sayohat va turizm sanoatida barqarorlikni ta'minlashda turizmni moliyalashtirishning muhim rolini o'rganadi. Tadqiqot maqsadli moliyalashtirish mexanizmlari ekologik toza infratuzilmani moliyalashtirish, past ta'sirli turizm modellarini ilgari surish va mahalliy hamjamiyatlarning imkoniyatlarini kengaytirish orqali turizmning barqaror rivojlanishini qanday qo'llab-quvvatlashi mumkinligini o'rganadi. Adabiyot tahliliga asoslangan sifatli tadqiqot yondashuvidan foydalangan holda, maqola turizmni moliyalashtirishning ettita asosiy manbasini ko'rib chiqadi, ularning uzoq muddatli ekologik, ijtimoiy va iqtisodiy maqsadlarga hissa qo'shish imkoniyatlarini baholaydi. Community-driven financing models, such as crowdfunding and local investment schemes, offer promising opportunities for small-scale, sustainable tourism projects.
